

CHAPTER ONE: (updated 14 August 2009)

Add note 4 to the notes on page 19:

4. *EPA's 2008 Report on the Environment* (EPA/600/R-07/045F), a peer-reviewed analysis available on the agency's web site, notes that ambient sulfur dioxide concentrations have fallen 48% since EPA implemented its acid rain program in 1990. The report also notes that carbon monoxide emissions decreased 35% from 1990 to 2002, principally due to reductions in motor vehicle emissions, and that ambient carbon monoxide concentrations fell 75% from 1980 to 2006.
